Discover Scuba Diving For people who just want to try out Scuba Diver Just have time for two days? Get your entry level certification and become a PADI Scuba Diver! Open Water Diver 3-4 days course including 4 open water dives. This certification allows you to dive with a buddy to a maximum depth of 18m. Advanced Open Water Diver 5 Adventure Dives including one deep dive and one navigation dive lead to this certification. Have two days of adventurous fun and become an Advanced Open Water Diver! Rescue Diver In this 3 days course you learn how to assist other divers. During your pool training and Open Water Scenarios you will act as a rescuer, get divers out of the water and administer first aid. Divemaster First professional rating. Duration at least 12 days, preferably 20-30 days. During this course you learn about diving theory, how to assist in courses and how to supervise certified divers. You will be the one who guides the divegroup so everyone will have a safe and enjoyable dive. Assistant Instructor You decided to become an instructor and want to teach classroom sessions already? Attend this one week course, learn the PADI standards and how to teach in the classroom. Open Water Scuba Instructor The Instructor Development Course (IDC) prepares you to attend the Instructor Examination (IE), a two days examination that qualifies for teaching the PADI system. We help you to find the right IDC depending on your language and personal needs.
